
Thank you all for being the spark! We appreciate all you do for Adopt A Class and for the students we serve. We wish you a fun and successful mentoring experience this year!



Essential Employability Skills

As always, mentors are encouraged to focus on STE(A)M and Career Exploration and Pathway activities during their classroom visits. We are also encouraging our mentors to focus on Essential Employability Skills. These skills highlight selfawareness, self-management, social awareness, relationship skills, and responsible decisionmaking skills and can be applied to any grade level!

So how do you choose which Essential Employability Skills you are helping students learn? Here are examples to help you and remember to complete your Mentor Tracker so we can know what students practiced in your activities!

- **Self-Awareness:** identifying and recognizing emotions; accurate self-perception; recognizing strengths, needs, and values; self-efficacy
- **Self-Management:** impulse control and stress management; selfmotivation and discipline; goal setting and organizational skills
- **Social Awareness:** perspective taking; empathy; difference recognition; respect for others
- **Relationship Skills:** communication, social engagement, and relationship building; working cooperatively; negotiation, refusal, and conflict management; help seeking
- **Responsible Decision-Making:** problem identification and situation analysis; problem solving; evaluation and reflection; personal, social, and ethical responsibility


ATTENTION ADOPT A CLASS EDUCATORS


